

Gas Network Upgrade – Snatts Road Uckfield

We are preparing to carry out essential upgrades to the gas network in the Snatts Road area of Uckfield. These works will help ensure a safe and reliable supply of gas continues to reach local homes and businesses. The project forms part of our 30-year programme to replace ageing mains with modern, durable plastic pipes.

Our contractor, WCB Utilities, will begin work on **Monday 5 January**.

Road Closures: To keep everyone safe while excavations are open, the following roads will be closed during the works. Please note, except for **Cambridge Way**, only one road will be closed at any one time:

- **Coopers Green Road** closed from **Monday 5 January** for approximately three to four weeks. Pipes will be replaced from outside Pine Cottage to the junction with London Road.
- Snatts Road will be closed once Coopers Green Road is reopened, with work expected to
 last for approximately five weeks. Signs confirming the start date will be in place two weeks
 prior to the road being closed. Pipes will be replaced along the full length of the road.
 Cambridge Way will also be closed for around two weeks while engineers work near the
 junction.
- Rocks Road closed from Saturday 14 February, during the school half-term holiday only.
 Pipes will be replaced from the junction with Snatts Road to the junction with Hunters Way.
 During this time Snatts Road will be temporarily re-opened, then closed again from Monday 23 February to complete any remaining work

Closure points will move progressively along each road as work advances. Our site team will liaise directly with residents to discuss local access arrangements. Signed diversions will be in place for motorists. Pedestrian access will remain open, though cyclists will need to dismount and walk through the works area.
